SUBJECT: Evaluation of the Canadian Sport Policy Final Report


On behalf of the FPTSC, we are pleased to provide you with an electronic copy of the Final Report of the Canadian Sport Policy Evaluation. The evaluation was conducted over the past year by The Sutcliffe Group Incorporated. The evaluation included, as one of seven data sources, a survey of all national and provincial/territorial sport and multisport service organizations. It is encouraging to note that more than 420 organizations submitted responses to the survey, representing a response rate of greater than 50% of those surveyed.

We also wish to inform you that government officials have recently initiated a process to renew the Canadian Sport Policy after 2012. As you may be aware, the policy was initially developed for the ten-year period of 2002-2012.

Focused consultations will be taking place over the coming months and, if there is a strong consensus to develop a new policy, as the final report of the evaluation suggests, additional and more extensive consultations would be conducted throughout all jurisdictions in 2011.

The Final Report of the Canadian Sport Policy Evaluation contains seven recommendations directed at the federal and provincial/territorial governments, collectively and individually. It is planned that governments will make public their response to these recommendations in the autumn.
